### MOVE STEADILY WITH FOCUS

Before the virus hit the world like a tonne of bricks, the construction and infrastructure sectors of India had been enjoying an upward trajectory. The sudden onset of COVID-19 has brought industry after industry to a

shrieking standstill worldwide. The architecture and construction industries have been affected as well; nonetheless, the outlook for 2020 can still be seen as promising. To start with, a good way to alleviate the damage and stay steady until the economy returns to a solid surface is to protect employees, job sites and clients from catastrophe, and then quickly implement the next best course of action. In these stressed times of the pandemic and lockdown, WFH has been a relatively pleasant and productive experience so far. Architecture, being a creative field, is not bound by the formalities of a structured workspace. As architects,

we experience inspiration in abundance around us and our creative minds can have a eureka moment for an idea at any place.

Technology today is a boon for communication, interaction, data storage and even data security. One large design studio has been fragmented into independent silos that are brought together at the click of a button to let the team feel as one. Systems have been put in place to work remotely, yet be a part of a whole.

Team engagement via daily reviews enables the productivity to be measured and targets to be met within timelines. Flexible work hours are making working from home more enjoyable, as long as deliverables stay in focus.

## **FAST TRACK ARCHITECTURE**



New Delhi-based firm, 42mm Architecture has unveiled a unique and quirky pool house that breaks many conventional architectural ideas with a bold design. The house was conceived as a stand-alone structure to complement the existing house, without replicating it. It accommodates a consolidated entertainment zone with a home theatre, lounge, pool, changing room, a gym and two suites with dressers and toilets.

Kriss Real Estate, a design centric developer, recently launched its debut project 'Si-Oul Villas' at Siolim, Goa. The firm worked with SAV architecture, an international contemporary architecture and design studio, to create a customised villa that would focus on the architecture of experiences and immersive interiors. Sol (Sun House) is the first of a trilogy of celestially-inspired, architecturally-inventive homes. The other villas, which are nearing completion, are similarly named after astral muses - Lua (Moon House) and Terra (Earth House).


