

According to Mathur, current situation of Pandemic witnessed mass reverse migration of the labour and have left a big question mark in front of the whole industry.

"Since, their accommodation / housing needs have never been addressed in an organized manner, at a policy level integrated with the city master plan, the people had no option but to trace back to their roots. Now, as the government has decided to restart work on government/ infrastructure projects, the biggest question is, where are the people who will do the real work on ground," said Mathur.

Architects says that this crisis will make a mark on cities, physically and socially, that will echo for generations.

"With the current scenario where affordable housing is also not affordable to many, the government needs to bring in subsidiary regulations and easy to take loan processes. This helps in ensuring housing-for-all is inclusive of all people, be it entrepreneurs or daily wage earners," Mathur added.
